Please attach your Curriculum Vitae to this form (optional).

All artwork submitted must be complete and ready to exhibit.

Submission not following the guidelines will not be accepted.

Late submissions will not be accepted.

Artists will be notified by **November 14, 2019**

If accepted, Workman Arts will store artwork(s) until **April 30, 2020**. Any artwork(s) left after this date will be considered abandoned and left for Workman Arts to dispose.
