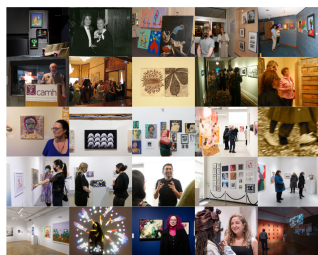

NOW ACCEPTING SUBMISSIONS FOR THE ICA PAS SCHOLARSHIP

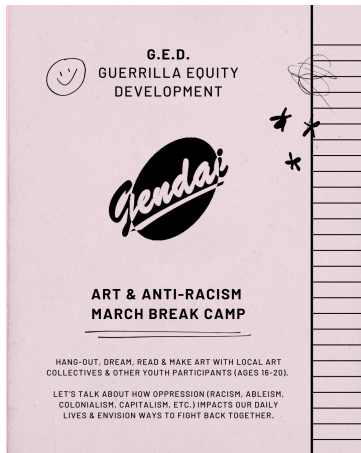
This award is dedicated to Ica Pas and all the other artists in TCH buildings who may fight silent battles and use their art to overcome and make it through another day.
